SUPPORTING CANADIANS

Canadians are feeling the rising cost of living, particularly through higher grocery bills, rent, and gas prices.

We are helping families weather inflation impacts by putting more money back in their pockets this year. We are:

- Putting up to an extra \$234 in the pockets of single Canadians without children and up to \$467 for couples with two children as well as an average of an extra \$255 for seniors this year by doubling the GST tax credit for six months.
- Providing up to \$1,300 over two years through a Canada Dental Benefit to children under 12, starting this year.
- Delivering \$500 to nearly 2 million low-income renters who are struggling with the cost of housing.



From cutting taxes for the middle class and raising them on the wealthiest 1%, to delivering a Canada Child Benefit, which puts more money back in the pockets of nine out of 10 families, to cutting child care fees in half by the end of this year for families across the country, we're focused on supporting Canadians.

CENTRE FLAVIE EXPANSION

Centre Flavie has been a staple in our community for over 40 years. Their mission is to provide comfort and support to those in need by distributing no cost material goods.

On August 30, at the grand opening of the new Centre Flavie building, I announced announced a \$500,000 investment toward the expansion of the Centre.

With support from PrairiesCan, Centre Flavie renovated their new space at 301 Archibald St. The renovations will enhance accessibility and accommodate the needs of the Centre, allowing it to store its most needed items, and double its current capacity.

The Centre annually serves around 7,000 women, children, and families. Those who seek the services offered by the Centre receive items, such as clothing and furniture, at no cost.

During a visit with Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, faculty and students in the Nursing program at Université de Saint-Boniface provided a very informative tour of their facilities and programs.



The Government of Canada (PrairiesCan) and the City of Winnipeg are investing more than \$1.6 million to support the St. Vital Mustangs project to upgrade the football field and surrounding area.



On July 29, I welcomed His Holiness Pope Francis to Iqaluit, Nunavut, at the start of his tour of the Territory to meet with Inuit.

NORTH END SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT

On August 16, the Government of Canada, the Government of Manitoba and the City of Winnipeg announced a joint investment of over \$550 million for the second phase of upgrades to the North End Sewage Treatment Plant in Winnipeg. The federal portion of the funding is \$200 million.

The North End Sewage Treatment Plant is Winnipeg's oldest and largest sewage facility, processing 70 percent of the city's wastewater. Phase 2 of the North End Sewage Treatment Plant Upgrades project will see construction of new infrastructure and upgrades to the Biosolids Facilities, which will store and treat sludge produced from the treatment of wastewater to convert it into biosolids, a nutrient-rich product that can be safely re-used as fertilizer or soil.



Thanks to more than \$90,000 in funding from the Canada Community-Building Fund, Royalwood's Fountainview Park will be upgraded to better serve the community.
